## DONATE A GIFT IN YOUR WILL...

### And leave a legacy that will live on!

Gifts in Wills provide a vital source of funding for Deaf Sports & Football Foundation. Leaving a gift in your will is a simple yet meaningful way of leaving a lasting gift.

### How to leave a gift in your will

We recommend you seek the advice of a solicitor to ensure that your wishes are carried out correctly.

If you are leaving a gift in your Will for the first time, then all you need to do is make sure your solicitor is aware of your plan to leave a gift to Deaf Sports & Football Foundation.

If you have already written your Will, then you just need to make a simple addition or amendment to your Will. To do this you just need to provide your solicitor with a completed **Codicil Form** (see overleaf).

### There are several ways to leave a gift

- **A residuary legacy:** this is a percentage of what remains of your estate after all other gifts and expenses have been paid.  
**Example wording:** *'I give to Deaf Sports & Football Foundation of ITEC R&D Enterprises, Rooms E3 & E4 TOB1, Earley Gate, University of Reading, Whiteknights Road, Reading, Berkshire, UK, RG6 7BE, Company Registration No 9164509 all [or .....% share] of my residuary estate for its general charitable purposes. I declare that the receipt of the duly Authorised Officer shall be a full and sufficient discharge to my executors.'*
- **A pecuniary legacy:** this is a gift of a fixed sum of money.  
**Example wording:** *'I give to Deaf Sports & Football Foundation of ITEC R&D Enterprises, Rooms E3 & E4 TOB1, Earley Gate, University of Reading, Whiteknights Road, Reading, Berkshire, UK, RG6 7BE, Company Registration No 9164509 free of all tax the sum of £..... for its general charitable purposes. I declare that the receipt of the duly authorised Officer shall be a full and sufficient discharge to my executors.'*
- **A specific legacy:** a specific gift or object, such as property, stocks and shares or personal items such as jewellery.
